From this week's Board meeting:

She replied that it was gifts for teenage boys that they were always short of at that time. The board has decided therefore to arrange to buy track pants, sweat tops and the like to give. At our next meetings Club members will be asked to pledge an amount so that Marilyn can proceed with the purchases (during sales etc)
- Behind the scenes, Lynne & Raewyn have worked hard to adapt the new by-laws for our club.
 They will be forwarded together with the standard Rotary NZ constitution to all members in anticipation of the vote to adopt them at the AGM.
- An opportunity exists to downsize our storage unit by selling unwanted items at a car-boot sale on 29th November at the Awapuni Raceway. Club members are welcome to donate items to sell as well.
