From this week's Board meeting:

- The amount raised from raffles, sunshine and \$10 donations on our PolioPlus night was about \$350. The board agreed to recommend that the Trust make this up to **\$1000** to be donated to the Rotary International for PolioPlus.
- The board agreed that awarding scholarships to four pupils of Takaro School should continue. The students are awarded for high standards of achievement in Year 8. The money is forwarded to their next year's high school for books, stationery, field trips etc. In line with inflation the board recommended the amount be increased to **\$300 each**.
- The club also makes a collection of small art/stationery items to be donated to Takaro School as prizes. Usual spend is up to **\$10**. Please bring these to the November 19th meeting as they will be presented to the school on Tuesday 2nd December.
- Bringing gifts to the Christmas dinner on December 17th. At a recent meeting, Jo from Women's Refuge was asked if she would like us to donate toys as we had done in the past. She replied that it was gifts for teenage boys that they were always short of at that time. The board has decided therefore to arrange to buy track pants, sweat tops and the like to give. At our next meetings Club members will be asked to pledge an amount so that Marilyn can proceed with the purchases (during sales etc)
- Behind the scenes, Lynne & Raewyn have worked hard to adapt the new by-laws for our club. They will be forwarded together with the standard Rotary NZ constitution to all members in anticipation of the vote to adopt them at the AGM.
- An opportunity exists to downsize our storage unit by selling unwanted items at a car-boot sale on 29th November at the Awapuni Raceway. Club members are welcome to donate items to sell as well.
